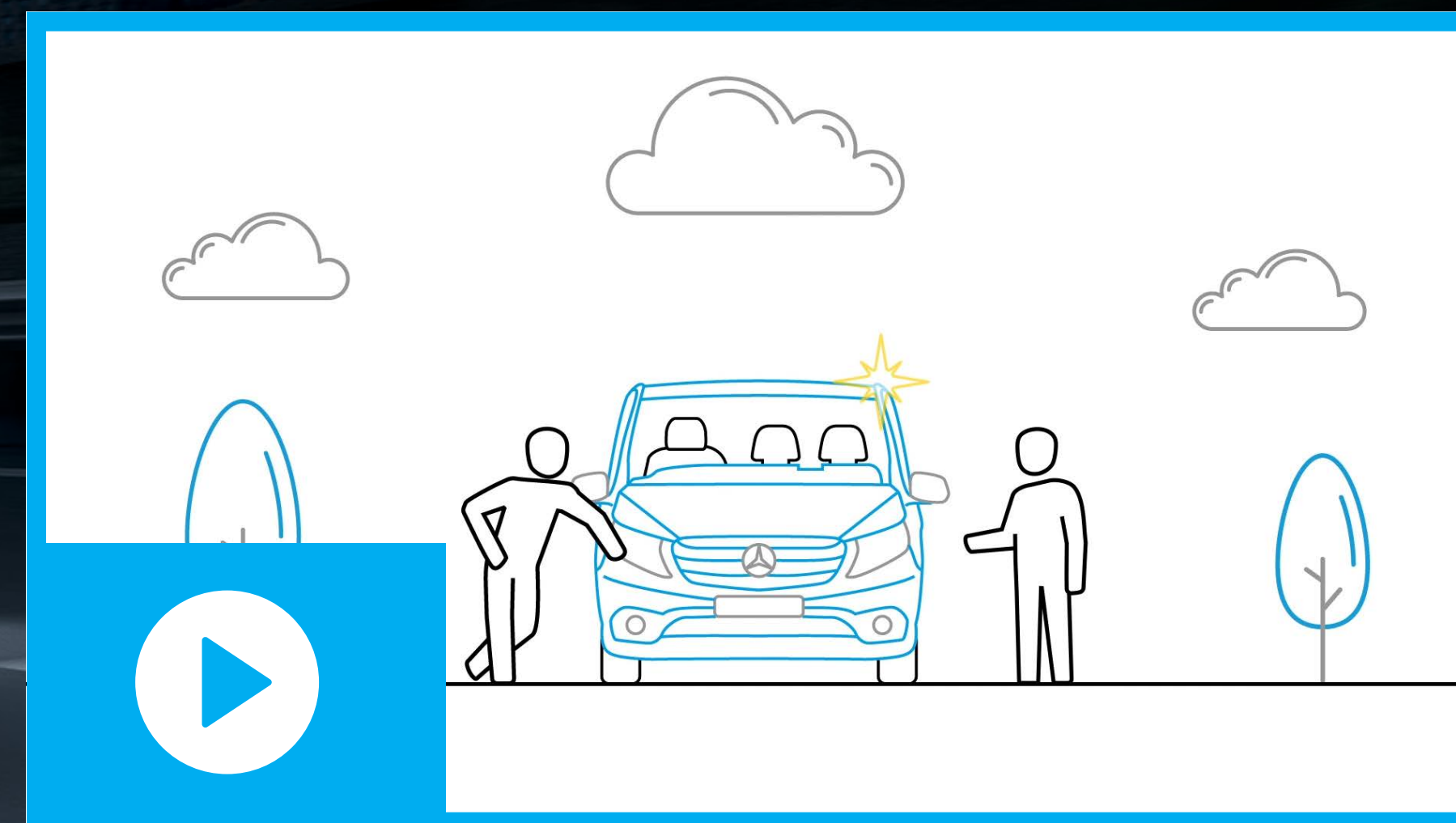




# What is eReady Finance?

# Running costs

Whether you're running a single eVan or a whole fleet, there are savings to be made compared with diesel and petrol.

## Today

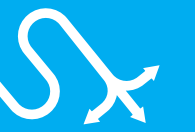
Fuel prices might go up and down in the short-term but filling up the tank will only get more expensive in the long term. Traditional vans with internal combustion engines have lots of moving parts that can go wrong, meaning maintenance costs could affect your business.



## Tomorrow

Electricity costs less than diesel or petrol, so plugging in rather than filling up makes good sense. Charging up overnight, rather than in the daytime, and doing a few simple things to optimise power consumption while driving can save even more.

Because eVans have fewer moving parts than traditional vehicles, they're cheaper and easier to run. "Regenerative braking" – where energy is recycled when you're not accelerating – can save on wear and tear of brake pads too.

Depending on your daily routines and driving behaviour, an electric van could save you money and hassle.

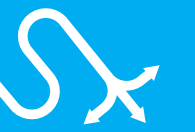
## Today

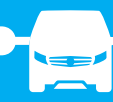

## Today

Exhaust emissions are polluting the air we breathe, damaging our health and affecting our climate. NO<sub>x</sub> (oxides of nitrogen) is an air pollutant that can irritate our lungs, cause inflammation of our airways and affect how our lungs work. CO<sub>2</sub> is a greenhouse gas that's linked to climate change and rising global temperatures<sup>1</sup>.

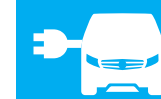

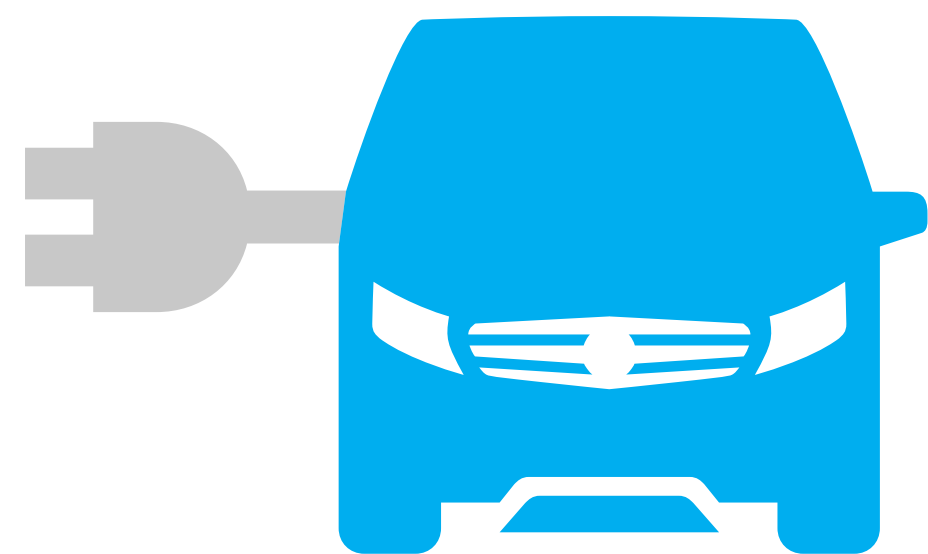


# Connectivity and charging

## Tomorrow

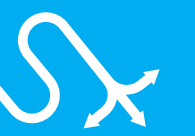

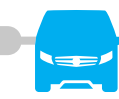

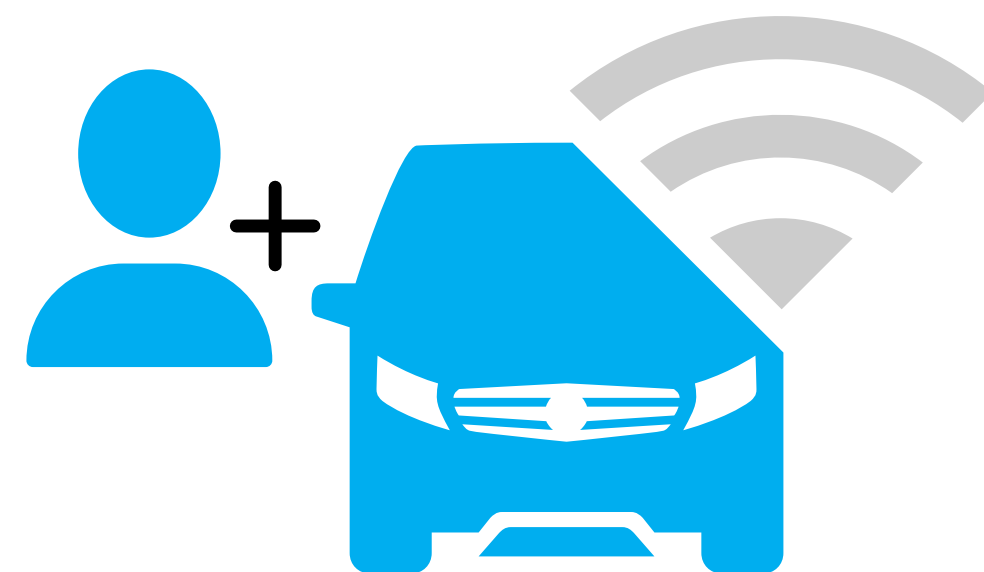


# Support

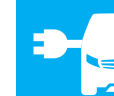

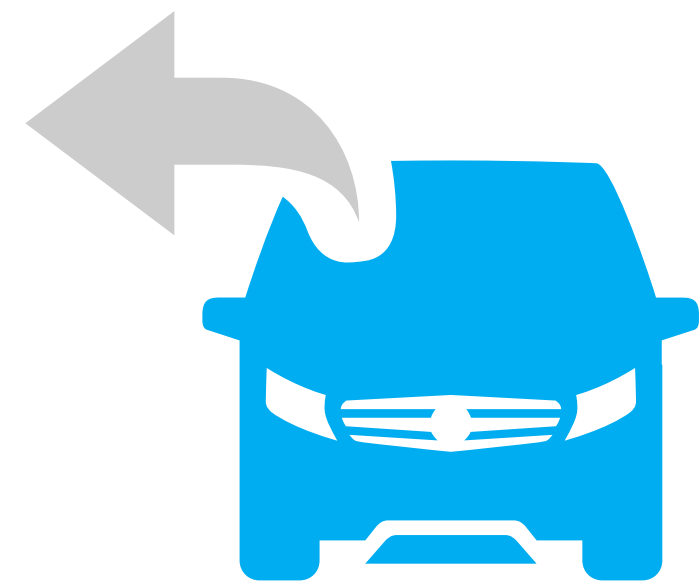

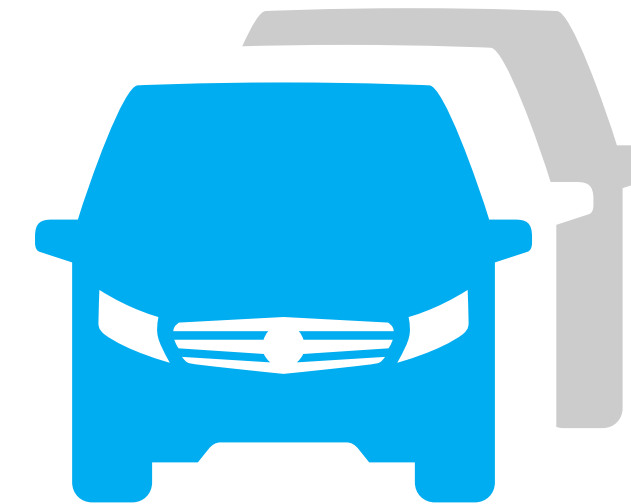
## 1. Return

Simply hand the eVan back and your contract with us ends.



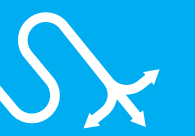
## 2. Replace

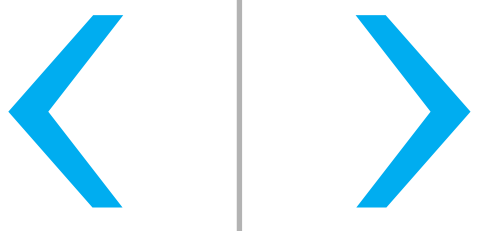

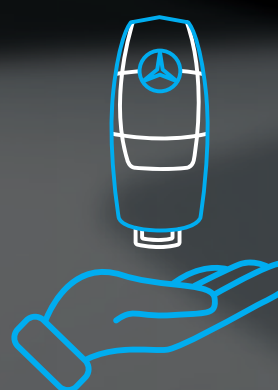

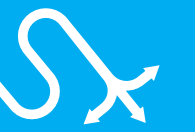
